



The Three Little Pigs

Characters: Narrator, Pig 1, Pig 2, Pig 3, Big Bad Wolf

Scene 1: Building the Houses

Narrator:

Once upon a time, three little pigs set out to build their homes.

Pig 1: (Pointing to an imaginary pile of straw)

I will build my house of straw!

(Pig 1 quickly stacks invisible straw and wipes his forehead with a proud smile.)

Pig 2: (Pointing to sticks)

I will build my house of sticks!

(Pig 2 pretends to hammer and nail sticks together, nodding with satisfaction.)

Pig 3: (Standing tall)

I will build my house of bricks!

(Pig 3 carefully stacks imaginary bricks and pats them firmly.)

Scene 2: The Wolf Arrives

Narrator:

But along came the Big Bad Wolf!

(The Wolf tiptoes in sneakily and knocks loudly on Pig 1's door.)

Wolf:

Little pig, little pig, let me come in!

Pig 1: (Shaking head)

Not by the hair of my chinny chin chin!

Wolf: (Taking a deep breath)

Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house in!

(Wolf blows dramatically, waving hands like wind. Pig 1's house "falls" and Pig 1 runs to Pig 2's house.)

(Repeat with Pig 2 and the stick house blowing down.)

Scene 3: The Brick House

Narrator:

The two little pigs ran to Pig 3's brick house. The wolf knocked again.

Wolf:

Little pigs, little pigs, let me come in!

Pig 3: (Confidently)

Not by the hair of my chinny chin chin!

Wolf:

Then I'll huff and I'll puff and I'll blow your house in!

(Wolf tries blowing but gets tired, hands on knees, panting.)

Narrator:

But the brick house was too strong!

Wolf: (Frustrated)

Oh no! I give up!

(Wolf stomps away, and the pigs cheer, jumping up and down.)

Narrator:

And the three little pigs lived happily ever after!
